ABSENTEE BALLOT REQUEST INSTRUCTIONS

Can't make it to the polls at election time? Any qualified Park County elector may request an Absentee Ballot for the Primary or the General Election or for both.

Follow these easy steps:

- Download and print the **Absentee Ballot Request** form on the elections home page.
- Completely fill out the **Absentee Ballot Request** form including signature
- Return the **Absentee Ballot Request** form to:

Absentee Ballot requests will be accepted until 5:00 p.m. August 18, 2008 for the Primary Election and 5:00 p.m. November 3, 2008 for the General Election.

A qualified elector may apply for an absentee ballot at any time during the calendar year in which the election is held, but not on the day of the election.

A qualified elector may apply for an absentee ballot either in person, in writing, or by telephone (307-587-8620, 307-754-8620, or 800-786-2844, ext. 8620.) by furnishing the following information:

Provide full legal name, date of birth, and current Wyoming residence address by street, city, county, and zip code or last Wyoming residence address. Fill out month and year of leaving Wyoming to live temporarily in another state or nation. If not obtained in person by the voter, the address to which the absentee ballot is to be mailed or the name of the individual the voter designates in writing to deliver the ballot to the voter is required by statute. Voter signature is required.

Ballots may be mailed to one address for the Primary election and to another address for the General election

All ballots must be returned to the Elections Office (1002 Sheridan Avenue in Cody) by 7:00 p.m. on election night to be counted.
